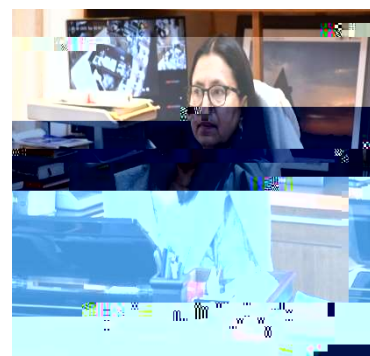

The library is fully computerized and automated with RFID Technology, with facility of Self check-in/check-out for issue/return of books. The Library has installed Patron Traffic Counter (PTC) for the convenience of the Users and to keep track of the footfall and Identification of the Users. The Library is subscribing to 281 current periodicals including online and print journals etc. The Library has subscribed to 15 e-resources including Science Direct, Scopus, IEEE, ACM Digital Library, EBSCO Proquest Dissertation & Thesis Abstracts, India stat, etc. The library is also getting access to 14 bibliographical databases in different disciplines through e-shodh.sindhu consortium of INFLIBNET. In totality, the Library is providing access to about 15000+ core and peer-reviewed online journals with links on the library website. The Library is providing library services for the registered users of the University through which the faculty, researchers and students of Punjab University can access thousands of e-journals, e-books and databases from anywhere 24x7. The e-library platform also provides mobile e-library app (for both Android and ios) which is a multi-format, content delivery app.

The library has digitized and uploaded 9115 theses on the Shodhganga platform. The Library is one of the six national document delivery centres of INFLIBNET for data information and also a member of JCC for document delivery.

The AC Jshi Library has implemented 'Earn while One Learn Scheme' which is now successfully implemented in the University under which the students are working in the various departments and earning for their education.

The AC Jshi Library has a special facility on the ground floor for the visually impaired students, which provides PCs with the JAWS, INDONDA and Zoomex software. Also it is equipped with the latest Horizon A3 Scanner, Lex Software with English and Hindi voice pack to assist them in their studies.

Parjab University Community Radio Station (CRS) - Jyotirmaya 91.2 MHz. The community radio station of Parjab University was inaugurated on 13th February, 2011 and is acting as a unifying agent amongst the university faculty, students and also the community. The station offers 3 sessions of broadcasts every day for over 12 hours duration. The radio programmes can be heard over a range of 10 Kms and the listenership base is on the rise.

The aim of setting up the CRS is to impart knowledge and information related to education, health and environment, social, cultural and local issues and to provide a platform for dialogue and discussion amongst the community members, students and faculty. Jyotirmaya serves as a platform for awareness generation, education and experience sharing with the community in the vicinity of the CRS. The students of the school, volunteers from other departments, interns and community members, with active help of the faculty and staff, generate the content. Community participation in the CRS is encouraged and the station takes measures, such as providing internship to students and training to interested members of the public. The doors of the CRS are open for all community members.

The Jyotirmaya 91.2 has broadcast several program and campaigns during the pandemic to create awareness about the COVID 19 scenario in collaborations with UNICEF, Health Ministry and Community Radio Association of India during 2019-22.

Jyotirmaya is setting new benchmarks every day. 'Hamari Beti' run by PU CRS was awarded by the Public Relations Council of India for its uniqueness. It has also been awarded a project from National Council for Science and Technology, Govt, New Delhi with Punjab State Council of Science and Technology for production of radio programmes on Women's Health and Nutrition. The *Pratidibha* programme, which is a Vardaan, Naari ka Samman has covered 365 topics on women's health. The station was able to connect the community with the experts from the fields of Medicine, Social Welfare, Nutrition, and Administration.

Punjab University Library is officially named as AC Joshi Library after an illustrious former Vice-Chancellor of Punjab University, Prof. AC Joshi. It is one of the largest University libraries of the country. Housed in a five-storey centrally air-conditioned building in red stone, it has spacious reading halls and compact stack areas, with open access. With modular design, it is based on modern principles of architecture. The main reading halls of the Library, facing the Shivalik Hills, provide a panoramic view of the natural surroundings.

Endowed with manuscripts on the one hand and online Databases on the other; periodical holdings going back to the 19th century on the one hand and reference material in multimedia on the other; textual and bibliographical material of the pre-Independence period on the one hand and the online sources on the other; Punjab University Library presents a blend of the old and the new under the same roof.

Facilities: The Library has a seating capacity for 850 readers (approx). It is a fully computerized library with an integrated system connected to the Campus network and possesses facilities like Wi-Fi, digital signage, photocopying, Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC), and online books and journals. Besides the two main reading halls, there are separate areas for text books, theses and rare books, newspapers, and current periodicals. There is an Outer Reading Hall for studying personal books in the Library that is open round the clock.

There is provision of 90 lodgers for faculty members and research scholars engaged in a serious research work.

The admission committee will assess the performance.

- 1) Admission shall be open to any Indian National who resides in any part of India, temporarily stays in a foreign country and who satisfies the admission requirements
- 2) *Foreign Nationals working in the foreign missions in India and their dependents residing with them may also apply for admission, subject to the condition that before submitting their Admission cum Examination Form, they are required to obtain Eligibility Certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Punjab University Chandigarh
- 3) *Foreign students who have passed BA/BCom Part I Examination from this University, shall be allowed to complete the remaining parts of these integrated courses through CDE even while staying in their respective countries, subject to the number of chances available in the respective examinations as provided in the Regulations
