Parjab University Library is officially named as AC Joshi Library after an illustrious former Vice Chancellor of Parjab University, Prof. AC Joshi. It is one of the largest University libraries of the country. Housed in a five storey centrally air conditioned building in redstone, it has spacious reading halls and compact stackareas, with open access. With modular design it is based on modern principles of architecture. The main reading halls of the Library, facing the Shivalik Hills, provide a pararamic view of the natural surroundings.
