ITFM 1

Amendment in Regulation 2.1 for M.Phil. Clinical Psychology (effective from the academic session 2022):

PRESENT REGULATION PROPOSED REGULAION 2.1 Candidate to be eligible to appear 2.1 Minimum educational for the M.Phil. Entrance Test, should requirement for admission to have passed as a regular candidate, this course shall be 2 years Master's examination in the subject M.A./M.Sc. degree in Psychology of Psychology with special paper in from a University recognized by Clinical Psychology, securing not less the UGC with a minimum of 55% than 55% (50% for SC) marks in marks in aggregate. For SC/ST aggregate from Panjab University or minimum of category, 50% from any other institute/University marks in aggregate is essential, examination of which has been as per Govt. of India. recognized as equivalent to the corresponding examination of this University.

ITFM 2

Amendment in Regulation 2.1(a) for Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) effective from the session 2022-23:

PRESENT REGULATION

first BDS examination of Panjab University or an examination of any other recognized University in India considered equivalent for the purpose by the Syndicate on the recommendation of the Faculty of Medical Sciences, shall be eligible to join the second year BDS class. However, a candidate who fails in the first BDS examination in the May/June examination for the first time may be allowed to attend the next higher class until December next but if he fails even in the November/ December examination. he shall revert to the first BDS

Addition in Regulation 1 for Bachelor of Science (Medical Laboratory Technology), Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology (X-Ray) and Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology (Anaesthesia and Operation Theatre Techniques) (three-year integrated course):

1. The Bachelor of Science (Medical 1. No Change Lab. Technology), Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology (X-Ray) and Bachelor of Science Medical Technology (Anaesthesia and Operation Theatre Techniques) will be a three-year integrated course. The course is to be run under annual system for the purpose University examination. However, internal assessment semester/House examinations will be held.

The students shall be allowed two years' period beyond the normal period to clear the backlog to be qualified for the degree for B.Sc. in (Medical Lab. Technology), B.Sc. in (X-Ray) and B.Sc. in (Anaesthesia and Operation

Addition in Regulation 1 for Bachelor of Optometry (B.Optom.) (three-year integrated course):

1. The duration of the course for Bachelor of Optometry (B.Optom.) shall be of four years. There shall be three academic years plus one year Compulsory Internship.	S
	The students shall be allowed two years' period beyond the normal period to clear the backlog to be qualified for the degree for B.Sc. Optometry (B.Optom.). However, in exceptional circumstances and on the basis of the merits of each case, University may allow a student one more year for the completion of the programme.

ITEM 7

Addition of Regulation 10.3 for M.Ed. Special Education (Learning Disability/Intellectual Disability) (Semester System):

- 10.3 Criteria for appointment of Supervisor for M.Ed. Special Education (Learning Disability/Intellectual Disability):
 - (i) Supervisor should be regular Faculty;
 - (ii) (a) Should have minimum 3 years experience in teaching Masters course in the subject concern;

OR

(b) Should have research experience (M.Phil./ Ph.D./ Funded Research Project) with research publication.

Moreover research experience at M.Phil./ Ph.D. level is to be taken care or having undertaken funded research projects.

Regulations for M.A. (Yoga) (Semester System) (effective from the session 2022-23):

1.1 The Master of Arts in Yoga (M.A. {Yoga}) Programme shall be of duration of two academic years, which can be completed in maximum of three years from the date of admission to the Programme. The intake numbers of seats are twenty (20) for the said course. There shall be at least two hundred working days each year exclusive of the period examination and admission.

The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall have to be 80% for all course work and 90% practicum.

- 1.2 The examination shall be held twice a year ordinarily in the months of May & December, on such dates as may be fixed by the Syndicate.
- 1.3 The Re-appear examination shall be held along with the semester end exam.
- 1.4 The last date for receipt of Examination admission form with and without late fee shall be as prescribed by the Syndicate from time to time.

The Schedule of dates fixed in accordance with Regulation 1.4 shall be notified by the Controller of Examinations to all the affiliated colleges.

- 2.1 The admission to M.A. (Yoga) shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination or any other selection process as per policy of state Govt./ U.T. administration and the University.
- 2.2 A person who possesses the following qualification shall be eligible to join the course:
 - (i) A Candidate with atleast 50% (Fifty Percent) marks in any Bachelor degree in Yoga or Bachelor of Education in Yoga or Graduation with one year Diploma/ Certificate course in Yoga Education or equivalent thereto is eligible for admission to the programme.
 - (ii) The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per rules of the admission policy of State

Govt./ Chandigarh Union Territory Administration, as the case may be.

- 2.2. No one who is in employment (Full time or honorary service) shall be allowed to join M.A. (Yoga) course without taking leave from his/her institution/office, etc. from the date of commencement of the academic session to the conclusion of her/his examination in student teaching.
- 3.1. A person who possesses the qualification laid down in Regulation 2.1, has been on the rolls of a college affiliated for the course for M.A. (Yoga) degree during the academic year preceding the examination, and produces the following certificates signed by the Principal of the college shall be eligible to appear in the examination:
 - (i) of good character;
 - (ii) of having qualified the house examination with atleast 40% marks in each paper and aggregate;

In case of a failure to get qualifying marks (in house test in any papers or parts, the candidate can appear in the test in the concerned paper(s) or part(s) along with the regular students in the next academic session.

6.2. The marks awarded to a candidate in the Internal Assessment shall be carried forward, when he is permitted under Regulation 9.1 to reappear in a part or parts at a subsequent examination. The marks obtained by a

- 10.3. Each successful candidate shall be awarded a degree stating the division obtained in the course.
- 11. A person doing M.A. (Yoga) degree from the Panjab University may not be allowed to appear as a regular candidate from any other University/Institution simultaneously.
- 12. A person who has been qualified for the award of the M.A. (Yoga) degree from the Panjab University may be allowed to reappear as a private candidate in the subject(s) in which he appeared earlier in the M.A. (Yoga) examination with a view to improve his/her performance, provided the candidate has in the meanwhile, not passed any higher course in the said Faculty.

For this purpose, he/she would be allowed to appear only within two consecutive chances from the date of his/her passing the M.A. (Yoga) examination and that he/she will have to take the reappear examination with the latest syllabus only.

- 8. The successful candidates shall be classified into three divisions as under:-
 - (a) Those who obtain 60 per cent or : First Division more of the aggregate marks.
 - (b) Those who obtain 50 per cent or: Second Division more but less than 59.9 per cent of the aggregate marks.
 - (c) Those who obtain less than 50 per : Third Division cent of the marks in aggregate.
- 9. Each successful candidate shall be granted a Certificate showing the division in which he/ she has passed together with the marks obtained by her/him and the aggregate marks.
