#### ITEM 5

Regulations for Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) examination (effective from the session 2006-2007) in anticipation of approval of various University bodies/Government of India/publication in the Government of India Gazette.

- 1.1 The duration of the course of instruction for the degree of Bachelor of Dental Surgery shall be five years, including one year compulsory paid rotatory internship.
- 1.2 There shall be four examinations, viz. first, second, third and final. The first examination shall be held at the end of first year, the second examination at the end of second year, the third examination at the end of third year and the final examination at the end of fourth year.
  - After the final examination, there will be one year's compulsory paid rotatory internship
- 1.3 These examinations shall be held twice a year on suitable dates in the months of May/June and November/December or at such a time as may be decided by the appropriate University authority from time to time.
- 1.4 A person who has attained the age of 17 years, or more on 31st December of the year of admission and possesses one of the following qualifications shall be eligible to join the first year class of the course after qualifying the entrance test:-
  - (i) 10+2 examination of the Punjab School Education Board/CBSE, New Delhi with at least 50 per cent marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology, provided he/she has

of the first Professional MBBS examination of Panjab University

- 5. The sessional marks awarded shall be forwarded by the Principal of the College to the University on the prescribed form at least 10 days before the commencement of the University examinations.
- 6. The minimum marks required to pass each examination to be held at the end of each year shall separately be 35% in each objective test and 45% in practicals consisting of sessional and examination marks taken together.
- 7. The final result will be compiled on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in all the four examinations taken together.
- 8. The successful candidates shall be classified as under:

(a)	Those who obtain 75% or more of the aggregate marks.	:	First Division with Distinction.
(b)	Those who obtain 60% or more but less than 70% of aggregate marks.	:	First Division
(c)	Those who obtain 50% or more but less than 60% of the aggregate marks.	:	Second Division
(d)	Those who obtain less than 50% of the aggregate marks	:	Third Division

9. A candidate who does not clear the Final examination within a period of six years of his/her admission to the first year shall not be allowed to continue his/her studies for 'Special Diploma' in Fine Arts.


## PRESENT REGULATIONS

# 1.1 The duration of the course for the degree of Bachelor of Science in Nursing including compulsory internship shall be four years, the first three years of which shall be divided into six semesters.

- PROPOSED REGULATIONS

  1. The duration of the course for the degree of B.Sc. Nursing (Annual System) shall be four years.
- 1.2 The examination for each semester shall ordinarily be held in the month of November/December and April/May on such dates as may be fixed by the Syndicate. A candidate who does not qualify in all the subjects of the preceding two semesters, even at the supplementary examination, but qualifies in 50% of the subjects in aggregate, shall have another chance of reappearing in the subjects in which the candidate has failed along with the current semester examination.
- After a candidate has passed the Sixth semester examination, there shall a compulsory internship of one year as described in Regulation 9.1.
- 2. The examination shall ordinarily be held in the month of April/May of each year or on such other dates as may be fixed by the Syndicate. A candidate failing in more than two subjects and/or nursing practical will not be promoted to next higher class. Maximum number attempts permitted for each paper shall be three (first examination, reappear examination and along with next higher class examination). Candidate shall not be admitted to subsequent higher examination unless the candidate has passed the lower examination (e.g. cleared all year subjects exams 3rd appearing in year subjects examination/2<sup>nd</sup> year examinations for appearing 4th year subject examination). The candidate has to pass both theory and practical examinations separately in each of the paper. The candidate, failing in either theory or practical paper, has to re-appear for both theory and practical examinations. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 8 years.
- 1.3 The last dates for receipt of examination admission forms and fees without late fees and with late fees of Rs.5, as fixed by the Syndicate shall be notified by the Controller of Examinations.
- 3. (a) The examination fee shall be decided by the Syndicate/Senate from time to time.
  - (b) The amount of admission fees and other charges shall be as decided by the Syndicate/Senate from time to time.
  - (c)The last dates for receipt of examination admission forms and fees, without late fees and with late fees, as fixed by the Syndicate from time to time, shall be notified by the Controller of Examinations.
- 2 A person who has passed one of the following examination and has attained/shall attain the minimum age of 17 years on December 31 of the year
- 4. A person who has passed 10+2 with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology with 50% aggregate marks from the recognized Board or

The marks for internal assessment for theory are derived from cumulative performance in theory various tests conducted from time to time, by the department. marks for internal assessment for practicals are given based on performance in practical conducted tests by department from time to time.
- (iii) Thesis project would be adjudged as 'Satisfactory" or "Unsatisfactory" and 'Satisfactory' should be taken as pass.
- (iv) A candidate who fails in the examination (Part I or Part II) after having completed the prescribed courses or fails to appear in the examination for valid reasons can appear in the supplementary examination. The marks for the internal assessment for the completed year will be said credited for the examination.
  - (v) If a candidate does not pass in 3 attempts, he/she will not be allowed to continue his M.Sc. studies for the examination in Physiology. However, the maximum duration of the course shall not exceed 3 years from his/her date of admission to The candidate the course. has to pass the Part I

  - (ii) First Division: A candidate who obtains 60% or more aggregate of marks of part I and Part II examination taken together.
