The theory exam will comprise of nine questions. The candidates shall be required to attempt five questions.

- Question No. 1 shall be compulsory, consisting of 10 short answer type questions, spread over the whole syllabus, to be answered in 30 to 35 words and carrying 2 marks each. (10 x 2 = 20 marks)
- In addition to Question No. 1, candidates are required to attempt 4 long answer type questions, by selecting one from each of the four units. Each unit shall have two questions of 20 marks each.

The practical exam will be based on written reports of Orientation Visits, Case Work, Group Work, Community Outreach Programme, and Internship. The examine the skills and techniques developed will be examined by conducting Viva and pres
