Outline of tests, syllabi and courses of reading for Post Graduate Diploma in Buddhist Studies for 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-21 Examinations

The course will consist of four papers in all. There would be three theory papers and one dissertation as a requirement for the fourth. All papers would carry 100 marks each. Out of 100 marks, 80 marks will be for main annual examination and 20 marks will be for internal assessment.

Student will be required to write a Dissertation on a topic as decided by the department (in consultation with course teacher). Student will be allotted topic at least 60 days prior to the commencement of final examination within the broad areas mentioned below:-

- 16. Concept of Truth in Buddhism
- 17. Buddhist Ethics
- 18. Buddhist Sects
